Rules and Regulations



<u>Registration Fee</u> of \$6 payable once only.

<u>TBA</u> Accredited <u>Tournament</u> all TBA rules and regulations apply, and all participants must be registered members of TBA for 2023.

<u>Scratch Event</u> with two divisions; Juniors and Adults. All bowlers will be placed in grades based on their entering average.

Junior Bowlers must not have reached the age of 18 years before 1 January 2023.

Adult Bowlers must have reached the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2023.

<u>Championships Events</u> will consist of singles, doubles and four-person team events in which each entrant will bowl three (3) games per event.

TBA Membership is required to bowl in this event. Membership registration and payment can be made online at <u>https://www.tenpinresults.com.au</u>.

<u>Closing Date</u> entries will be accepted until 5 minutes before the start of any squad subject to squad availability. Participants are encouraged to lodge entries early to receive preferred squads.

<u>Entry Fees</u> all fees must be paid when booking online through Tenpin Results to secure squads.

Event Qualifying will cost \$10 an attempt for all Masters/Cup events. Masters/Cup qualifying needs to be paid at the check-in desk before the commencement of a qualifying squad.

<u>Refunds</u> will not be issued. Bowlers who are unable to bowl in their squad can sell their spot to another competitor by going online to Tenpin Results and altering the name of the bowler.

Entering Averages will be taken from a bowler's highest league or regular tournament average established over 18 games as of 30 November 2022.

No Average where a bowler does not have an established average, they may apply to the Tournament Director for grading; otherwise, an average of 185 for Women, 195 for Men, 175 for Junior Girls and 185 for Junior Boys will be used.

<u>Protests</u> must be made within 30 minutes of the alleged offense with the Tournament Director.

<u>Average Reclassification</u> the Tournament Director reserves the right to reclassify any participants average at any time.

Prize Money and Trophy Fund All monies subscribed, as Prize Fund for any event listed in this entry form (unless otherwise stated) shall be returned 100% based on one prize for every five (5) entries. Juniors will receive medals for 1st, 2^{nd,} and 3rd places in each division if applicable. Juniors will also receive prize fund if there is surplus prize fund after medals have been awarded.

<u>Replacements</u> or changes to the original team line-up must be organised online through Tenpin Results and the

Tournament Team advised at least 45 minutes prior to the Squad time.

<u>Check-in</u> participants must check-in 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their squad. Failure to do so may result in the squad being filled by someone else.

All-Events will be taken from a bowler's highest singles, doubles, and teams' squad during the Championships. A bowler must register online for an All Events entry and pay \$6.00 prior to bowling any squads. Only one paid all-events entry per participant will be accepted. Bowlers wishing to compete in the Junior and Adult Restricted Masters, Junior and Adult Open Masters and the Seniors Cup need to complete and All Event to qualify for these events. Bowlers wishing to nominate for a 2023 State Team need to complete an All Event in these championships to be eligible for any teams.

<u>Multiple Participation</u> participants can enter events as many times as they wish excluding all-events.

<u>Smoking & Alcohol</u> consumption is strictly prohibited during play.

<u>Dress</u> <u>C</u>ode acceptable dress will be determined by the Tournament Director but singlets, stubbies, shorts (dress shorts only permitted), track pants, cargo pants and jeans will not be accepted.

Tournament Committee reserves the right to make decisions regarding any matter not covered in these rules.

Acceptance of Rules is assumed with entry and as such no claim of ignorance will be accepted.

- Tenpin SA will call for nominations for participants through a Tenpin SA representative or the Tenpin SA State Champs Facebook page <u>https://www.facebook.com/TenpinSAStateChamps</u> in the months leading up to the 2023 State Championships
- Each Team will have a Celebrity Captain, who will be selected by Tenpin SA
- Teams will be selected by a Facebook live random name draw leading up to the event.
- This is a handicapped event based on the entering average of the bowler in the State Championships. The Handicap will be established once all bowlers have nominated for this event and will be 100% of the highest average entered plus 10pins.

Event Info	 This is a handicapped event with one division. The Handicap will be established once all bowlers have nominated for this event and will be 100% of the highest average entered plus 10pins. Each participant will bowl three games with their nominated partner in any doubles squad of the State Championships Nominations and all fees must be paid prior to or at check-in for the squad wishing to be used for this event The doubles line-up must be detailed on registration and may be altered at check-in but cannot be changed after this time Multiple participation is permitted, and bowlers may enter with more than one doubles partner if these represent separate entries Each entry will be \$76.00 per doubles combination The winner of this event will be the doubles combination with the highest pinfall plus handicap. The 2023 South Australian State Championships rules and regulations apply to this tournament, except for where there are inconsistencies and the rules in this section shall apply.
