Nominations are open for adults to represent Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. at the 2023 North Queensland Intercity Shield to be held at Mackay Leisure Centre, 95 Broadsound Road, Paget, Qld, 4740 on Saturday 29th April 2023 to Monday 1st May 2023. Four teams are required Male and Female Scratch, Male and Female Handicap. Averages for Handicap Teams cannot exceed 180 for men and 170 for women. We require 6 bowlers for each team. (Total 24 Bowlers)

Eligibility: Open to all persons who have obtained the age of 18 years as of 1/1/2023 who have paid their initial 2023 TBA membership with Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. and who meet the eligibility criteria on page 2.

Selection is conditional on all bowlers having bowled All Events at the Townsville Championships in 2022. Any bowler who cannot meet the relevant criteria (2022 championships) must apply for an exemption to be eligible to roll- off, this includes exemptions for those who did not compete, must be received by the secretary by 10th February 2023.

ROLL-OFF: Teams will be selected by a Roll-off and selection, to be held on Sunday 26th February 2023. Check-in closes at 9.15 am bowl at 9.30 am. A Roll-Off will include Eight games bowled on Sunday 26th February 2023. Handicap for Male and Female Handicap Teams to be used is 100% of 300. Averages to be used for the roll-off will be the highest league average obtained over at least 24 games, as at 31st December 2022. The top four (4) bowlers in each division will be automatically in the team with a further two (2) for each team selected by the Selection Panel. Cut-off averages for handicap teams will be men 180 and women 170.

Closing Date: Nominations close Friday 17th February 2023 at 6.00 P.M.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. All TBA rules and regulations apply
- 2. Must have attained the age of 18 years as of 1/1/2023.

- 4. You must be currently bowling to a weekly schedule in an accredited league at Townsville Tenpin & Fun Centre and have bowled at least 24 games as at 31st December 2022.
- 5. You must be a team player. The Manager/Captain chooses the line-ups and bowlers must be prepared to accept this decision. You must be prepared to sit out when asked to for the betterment of the team. Refusal to do so may result in your being stood down for the remainder of the tournament. There are no guarantees regarding the number of games any bowler may be asked to bowl.
- 6. Must abide by all TBA Rules and Regulations and Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. Code of Ethics. Any misconduct will not be tolerated, and bowlers may be stood down from the competition.
- 7. Must have bowled All Events in the Townsville Annual Championships in 2022.
- 8. Must have bowled at least the last six months prior to the closing date of nominations in an accredited league at Townsville Tenpin & Fun Centre.
- 9. Refunds for late withdrawal will be at the T.B.A.T.'s discretion.
- 10. A brief resume is required to be supplied with all nominations for selection purposes. Any bowlers not submitting a resume will be ineligible for selection process. Resumes to be forwarded to tsv.secretary@nqtenpin.com.au no later than Friday 10th February 2022 at 6.00 pm.
- 11. No late nominations will be accepted.
- 12. Roll-off Exemptions. Requests for Exemptions:

It is preferable all nominees attend the roll off. However, any bowler seeking to be exempted from participating in the 8 games roll off needs to submit a written request for exemption to The Secretary of Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. no later than 6.00 pm Friday 10th February 2023, with the exception of emergency medical or personal exemptions. Any application for an exemption must be accompanied by a brief resume and a detailed reason as to why the exemption is being requested, along with verifiable confirmation (i.e. a medical certificate, letter from employer, etc.). All requests will be verified by The Tournament Committee who will forward any exemptions to the TBAT Executive who will have the final say.

Should the request for an exemption be granted, the applicable bowler will be included in the bowlers considered for selection. However, an exemption is not an assurance of your selection in the team.

TIES: If a tie should occur for the 4th placing the highest last game score will be used to break the tie
