Entry Fee

(Entry fee to be paid at registration)

Total cost for Open Bowlers will be \$110.00 Total cost for Restricted Bowlers will be \$90.00

Tournament is limited to 48 bowlers (based on 3 per pair for 16 lanes)

Tournament Director may adjust limit of bowlers depending on nominations

Check-in closes at 03.30pm

Prize Fund (Prize money will be dependent on entries)

Format

All bowlers will bowl 8 games in their respective divisions.

All Bowlers will move lanes after 2 games: left lane moving left and right lane moving right.

Eligibility

The tournament is open to Adult Bowlers who TBAL registered bowlers, who are bowling in a TBA scheduled league at the Mackay Leisure Centre, and are currently residing in the Mackay Area for a period of 3 months immediately prior to closing date of championships.

Bowlers can only nominate for one Division in the Mackay Adult Masters

Each division must have a minimum of 3 nominations

Averages to use

The current averages as of 10th of November 2023. An average must be established over a minimum of 24 games in any league.

Bowlers without an Average

A bowler without an average must apply to the Tournament Coordinator for an average to be assigned.

All relevant information required by the Coordinator, to assign an average, must be supplied by the bowler.

Application must be made prior to closing date of entries

Restricted Masters

This is a handicap tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) open to all adult bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause.

Cut off averages: Men: 184 or less Ladies: 174 or less.

The Restricted Handicap is 100% of 200.

In addition, the Tournament Director has the right to regrade any bowler or entry.

The bowler with the highest pinfall plus handicap over the 8 games will be declared the 2023 Restricted Masters winner.

Throughout this tournament all ties will be decided by the highest last game, plus handicap.

The champion will receive: 60% of prize fund and shirt and will have an unpaid entry into the 2024 North Queensland Adult Masters.

Second place will receive 27% of prize fund Third place will receive 13% of prize fund

Open Masters

This is a scratch tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) and open to all adult bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause.

The bowler with the highest pinfall over the 8 games will be declared 2023 Open Masters winner.

Throughout this tournament all ties will be decided by the highest last scratch game.

The champion will receive: 60% of prize fund and shirt and will have an unpaid entry into the 2024 North Queensland Adult Masters.

(if applicable)

Second place will receive 27% of prize fund Third place will receive 13% of prize fund

Rules

This is an accredited event and all TBA tournament rules, regulations and the Code of Ethics will apply.

All other matters which may arise and are not covered in these Tournament Rules will be decided by the Tournament Directors.

(If required the tournament director may seek advice from the TMBA executive)

No smoking or consumption of alcohol is permitted whilst bowling in the tournament.

Personal entertainment systems (mp3, iPods, iPads, etc.) will not be allowed in the players' area.

The use of mobile phones and/or 'apps' will not be permitted in the players' area.

Unsporting conduct will not be tolerated.

Only bowlers participating in the tournament are permitted in the player's area during the tournament.

Bowler Conduct

Competitors must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect negatively on TBA, TBMA or the sport of Tenpin Bowling.

The Tournament Director has the right to penalise bowlers for violations of the TBA Code of Conduct.

Dress Code

Neat tidy acceptable bowling attire is required. No denim, singlets, hats, yoga pants or track suite pants allowed.

Tournament director's decision shall be final.
