Restricted/Handicap Event

The remainder of the field out of the cut will have their handicap added to their qualifying pin fall. The top 4 bowlers in the handicap division will proceed to the final on Monday 1st July.

Handicap – 90% of 220 **, averages submitted are to be taken from the bowler's highest league average over minimum of 16 games as at 15th June 2024. Bowlers are to provide a <u>certified average</u> by your home Centre when checking in to be eligible to enter the Handicap Division (if not able to be verified via <u>www.tenpinresults.com.au</u>).

**The Tournament director reserves the right to alter the handicap percentage for the Handicap Division to comply with TBA Rules & Regulations.

Under 21 Queensland Youth Cup

This is a scratch event open to all youth bowlers (male and female). This year's event will have separate Male and Female divisions.

Rules & Regulations

TBA rules and regulations will apply and all bowlers must adhere to the following:

- 1. Be a 2024 TBA registered member and produce their card (or receipt) at check-in if requested.
- 2. For Queensland Junior Cup, be under the age of 18 as at 1st January 2024
- 3. For Queensland Youth Cup, be under the age of 21 as at 1st January 2024
- 4. To be eligible for ranking points (QJC only Qld Youth Cup is not ranked), your Silver Membership must be paid by Friday 28th June 2024.
- 5. Have the entry fee(s) paid in full by 17th June 2024.
- 6. Check-in by the advertised time.
- 7. Dress in appropriate bowling attire. Bowling shirt either with the bowler's name or an industry produced shirt, dress trousers, long dress shorts or skirt. No denim or short shorts.
- 8. Dress code for all finals is appropriate bowling attire. Bowling shirt either with the bowler's name or an industry produced shirt, long dress trousers for Males and long trousers, Dress Shorts, Skorts or Skirts for Females.
- 9. Have all bowling equipment meet TBA regulations.
- 10. The tournament Director and event staff have the right to check any equipment as they deem necessary.
- 11. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke or consume alcohol whilst competing in the tournament.
- 12. The Tournament Director and event staff have the final say in all matters.
- 13. Final placings will be determined by overall pinfall. In the event of a tie in "qualifying" the highest last game played by the participants will decide the winner. For the "Finals", any ties require a 1-game playoff. If scores remain tied after this, then a 9th & 10th frame shoot out will continue until the tie is broken.
- 14. If a bowler takes up the re-entry offer the two (2) highest 6-block scores will be used to determine their placing.
- 15. Refund of Entry Fees Should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the Tournament Director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options. 1. Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries, OR 2. Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee (3%)
- 16. Tournament Director reserves the right to add or reduce squads in line with demand and lane availability from our Host Centre.

PLEASE NOTE QUALIFYING FOR THE 2024 QJC & QYC IS 12 GAMES (you will need to nominate into a minimum of 2 squads).

Top 12 males (U18) and top 12 females (U18) on pin fall qualify for Stage 2 of the QJC. The remainder of the U18 field out of the cut will have their handicap added to their qualifying pinfall. The top four bowlers will compete in Graded final.

Only bowlers that have provided certified averages on or before check-in will be eligible for the Graded division.

Top 4 males (U21) and top 4 females (U21) will contest the final of the 2024 Queensland Youth Cup.

Award Ceremony will be conducted at the conclusion of the Finals.

QJC (U18 Open Boys & Girls)

Top 12 boys and top 12 girls, will bowl a further 5 games with pinfall to carry over. At the conclusion of these games, the field will be cut to top 6 boys and top 6 girls – who will progress through to matchplay. Pinfall will carry over.

Matchplay – 5 games of head to head round robin, with 30 bonus pins for a win and 15 bonus for a tie.

The boy and girl with the highest aggregate pinfall after the matchplay round (incl bonus pins), will be declared the 2024 Queensland Junior Cup Champions.

RESTRICTED DIVISION

Top 4 in the handicap division will contest the stepladder final. Pinfall will drop from qualifying.

Each Round will consist of 2 games with the winner of each round being highest aggregate pinfall incl handicap

Round 1 Seed 3 v Seed 4

Round 2 Winner Round 1 v Seed 2 Round 3 Winner Round 2 v Seed 1

The winner of Round 3 will be declared the 2024 QJC Restricted Champion.

UNDER 21 Queensland Youth Cup

Top 4 from qualifying will contest the final. Pinfall will be dropped.

Round 1 – All 4 competitors will bowl 1 game, with the lowest game eliminated.

Round 2 – Pinfall drops. The remaining 3 male and female competitors from Round 1, will play a further 1 game, with the lowest pinfall for that game eliminated.

Round 3 – Pinfall drops. The remaining 2 male and female competitors from round 1 will play a 2-game final with the competitors with the highest 2-game pinfall over these 2 games declared the male and female 2024 Queensland Youth Cup champions.
