QUALIFYING

All bowlers to bowl 12 games with handicap included in 2 appearances.

Lane change every 2 games.

Up to 4 bowlers per pair.

*subject to squad numbers to ensure fairness to all bowlers.

MATCH PLAY FINAL - PINFALL DROPPED

The top 15 bowlers on pinfall including handicap after Qualifying will progress to match play consisting of 7 games, 3 way match play. Bonus pins applied will be 20 pins for 1st, 10 pins for 2nd and 0 pins for 3rd place each match.

MATCH PLAY POSITIONAL ROUND - PINFALL CARRIES

At the completion of match play, bowlers will be seeded 1—15 for a final positional game E.g. 1 v 2 v 3, 4 v 5 v 6, and so on down to 15th.

ANY TIES FOR 1st WILL BE DETERMINED BY SINGLE GAME ROLLOFF

The bowler with the highest pinfall + handicap + bonuses will be declared the 2024 WHITE PHANTOM LADIES HANDICAP CLASSIC Champion and will receive free entry into the 2025 tournament.

TOURNAMENT RULES & CONDITIONS

- This is a handicapped event open to female bowlers who are 2024 TBA registered members. All games are bowled in accordance with TBA rules & regulations.
- ♦ The handicap will be 90% and shall be figured on the difference of each individuals average and a base figure at least 5 pins higher than the highest entering average, so every bowler has a positive handicap. Averages will be highest established league average (min 18 games) as of September 30th 2024.
- Dress Code: Appropriate shirt, skirts, mid-thigh shorts, skorts, slacks and 3/4 pants will be permitted - NO denim or track pants or gym tights.
- Smoking, alcohol and use of mobile phones will not be permitted whilst competing.
- ♦ No puff balls or resin balls in the players area if not in a concealed bag.
- The tournament directors reserve the right to scrutinise any equipment at any time. Any non-sanctioned equipment or equipment to be found non-compliant or in breach of TBA rules and regulations by any bowler, will result in instant disqualification and no claim to any prize money.
- Ties. In the result of any ties after qualifying for the Top 15, the highest last game with handicap will decide the highest position. At the end of Match Play, if any ties, a 1 game play off will decide the highest position. If a tie occurs for 1st after positional round a 1 game play off will take place to determine a winner. If still tied, a single ball playoff will be used to break any further tie.
- Any bowler to not check-in for any Final rounds on time will be replaced by the first available placegetter, e.g. top 15, if 1 person fails to check-in then 16th place will be offered a spot to progress and so on until place is filled.
- ♦ Any other matters not covered above, will be determined by the tournament directors.
