

2022 Roll-off Townsville N.Q.I.S. Team

Nominations are open for Adults to represent Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. at the 2022 North Queensland Intercity Shield to be held in Atherton. Four teams are required Male and Female Scratch, Male and Female Handicap. Averages for Handicap Teams cannot exceed 180 for men and 170 for women. We require 6 bowlers for each team. (Total 24 Bowlers)

Where: N.Q. Tenpin, 11-13 Eclipse Street, Atherton, 4883

When: Saturday 30th April 2022 to Monday 2nd May 2022.

Approximate Cost: Intercity fees approx. \$120.00, Intercity Shirts approx. \$50.00 each. All monies have to be paid by Friday 9th April, 2022. Accommodation in Atherton is the responsibility of individual bowlers.

Eligibility: Open to all persons who have obtained the age of 18 years as of 1/1/2022 who have paid their initial 2022 TBA membership with Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc.

Selection is conditional on all bowlers having bowled All Events at the Townsville Championships in 2021. Any bowler who cannot meet the relevant criteria must apply for an exemption to be eligible to roll-off, this includes Exemptions for those who did not compete, must be received by the secretary with this form.

What to do: Complete the nomination form and return via email ONLY to the Association Secretary.

Teams will be selected by a Roll-off and selection to be held on Sunday 13th February 2022. If selected into the team, acceptance and initial payment of \$100.00 is required within 7 days of selection to secure your position in the team.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. All TBA rules and regulations apply
2. Must have attained the age of 18 years as of 1/1/2022.
3. Must have paid initial Registration for 2022 with Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. and have resided in the area for the last six months.
4. You must be currently bowling to a weekly schedule in an accredited league at Townsville Tenpin & Fun Centre and have bowled at least 24 games as at 31st December 2021.
5. You must be a team player. The Manager/Captain chooses the line-ups and bowlers must be prepared to accept this decision. You must be prepared to sit out when asked to for the betterment of the team. Refusal to do so may result in your being stood down for the remainder of the tournament. There are no guarantees regarding the number of games any bowler may be asked to bowl.
6. Must abide by all TBA Rules and Regulations and Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. Code of Ethic. Any misconduct will not be tolerated and bowlers may be stood down from the competition.
7. Must have bowled All Events in the Townsville Annual Championships in 2021.
8. Must have bowled at least the last six months prior to the closing date of nominations in an accredited league at Townsville Tenpin & Fun Centre.
9. Refunds for late withdrawal will be at the T.B.A.T.'s discretion.
10. **A brief resume is required to be supplied with all nominations for selection purposes.** Any bowlers not submitting a resume will be ineligible for selection process. Nomination form and resume to be forwarded to tsv.secretary@nqtenpin.com.au
11. **ROLL-OFF:** : A Roll-Off will include Eight games bowled on Sunday 13th February 2022 Check-in closes at 9.15 am. Handicap for Male and Female Handicap Team to be used is 100% of 300. Averages to be used for the roll-off will be the highest league average obtained over at least 24 games, as at 31st December 2021. The top four (4) bowlers in each division will be automatically in the team with a further two (2) for each team selected by the Selection Panel. Cut-off averages for handicap teams will be men 180 and women 170

COST OF ROLL-OFF: Roll of will consist of 8 games in 4 by 2 game blocks, Cost of Roll-off is \$62.00 payable at time of nomination.

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12. If a tie should occur for the 4th placing the highest last game score will be used to break the tie.
13. No late nominations will be accepted.
14. **Roll-off Exemptions. Requests for Exemptions:**
It is preferable all nominees attend the roll off. However, any bowler seeking to be exempted from participating in the 8 game roll off needs to submit a written request for exemption to The Secretary of Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. no later than 6.00 pm Wednesday 9th February 2022.with the exception of emergency medical or personal exemptions. Any application for an exemption must be accompanied by the full nomination form, a brief resume and a detailed reason as to why the exemption is being requested, along with verifiable confirmation (i.e. a medical certificate, letter from

employer, etc.). All requests will be verified by The Tournament Committee who will forward any exemptions to the TBAT Executive who will have the final say. Should the request for an exemption be granted, the applicable bowler will be included in the bowlers considered for selection. However, an exemption is not an assurance of your selection in the team.

SPECIAL COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

Tenpin Bowling Centres are categorised as **Indoor entertainment venues** and therefore participants at all **Tenpin Bowling venues will need to be vaccinated**. At venues with cafes and bars, unvaccinated customers are still able to collect takeaway. Indoor sport and recreation participants will need to look after hand hygiene, social distance protocols, comply with occupancy density regulations, check in via the QR code app, wear facemasks at all times seated or standing, facemasks may be removed while actively bowling. Penalties will apply to venues not observing COVID -19 precautions – fines up to \$14K and imprisonment.

Tournaments and competitions:

Strategies to continue planned events:

Provide information to de-risk spread of virus at your event.

Survey those intending to come to ensure your event is still viable. Inform participants of the requirements here in Qld:

- Hand hygiene,
- Social distance protocols,
- Comply with occupancy density regulations,
- Check in via the Queensland QR code app,
- Wear facemasks at all times seated or standing,
- Facemasks may be removed while actively bowling.
- Be flexible to provide a level of comfort with regard to refunds to provide a level of comfort for persons supporting your event
- Reduce spectators where possible – provide outside livestream for spectators if possible
- Advise participants to arrive as close to timeline of starting to bowl as possible - Provide check in options - off site.
- Communicate refund flexibility should entrants be tested positive
- Be flexible, If event counts towards a points total or selection in teams - offer alternatives
- If you are not well, there will be zero tolerance and you will not be permitted to bowl or stay at the venue
- Ask entrants to keep in their own bubble as much as possible including after hours at accommodation places
- For the safety of others it is recommended to have a RAT test prior to bowling if you have any symptoms.
- Participant have proof of vaccination

- Staff and volunteers delivering sport and recreation services in Qld will need to be double vaccinated
