Open to all TBA members who meet the definition of a bowler with a disability. Registered Players who bowl in Leagues at a TBA Registered Centre in WA. TBA/TBAWA, define a bowler with a disability as a person who suffers from a condition that has limitation, restriction or impairment, that restricts everyday activity. The condition is permanent. It should be noted that degree of degrees of pain are not considered a disability. A bowler needs to provide one of the following types of evidence, if requested: Valid Disability Support Pension Card, Child Disability Allowance, Classification from TBAL, Deaf Sports, Blind Sports Australia, Wheelchair Sports Australia or Ausrapid, or state affiliated associations. Letter from a medical or educational professional: Physiotherapist/Occupational Therapist. Principal of an educational organisation, Psychologist, General Medical Practitioner, Audiologist or Ophthalmologist. Visual evidence in the case of short stature or participants that are amputees. Each bowler must be able to provide evidence of their disability at any time during the tournament if requested. All of the above as per rule 214 of the TBAL rule book.

OPEN MASTERS – This is a scratch event open to male and female bowlers whose average as at 1st December 2024 was **160 and above**.

CLASSIC MASTERS – This is a handicap event based on 100% of 200 open to male and female bowlers whose average as at 1st December 2024 is **between 159 and 120**.

RESTRICTED MASTERS – This is a handicap event based on 100% of 200 open to all male and female bowlers whose average as at 1st December 2024 was **119 and below**.

ALL TBA RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL APPLY THROUGHOUT THE TOURNAMENT

Format – Each Bowler will bowl 6 games moving after 2 games.

Dress Code – Dress Trousers/Dress Shorts (No Labels) for Males. Skirts, Dress Shorts, Slacks or 3/4 Pants for Females. A collared Bowling shirt is required, preferably with the bowlers name on. Shirts with another bowlers name on not allowed. No Track pants, cargo pants or Denim allowed.

WA STATE OPEN, CLASSIC AND RESTRICTED MASTERS 2025 FOR PEOPLE WITH A DISABILITY

Each bowler will bowl 6 games moving after two games

The top 2 in the Open, the top 2 in Classic and the top 2 in the Restricted division will then contest a 1 game step ladder.

If there is a tie for 2nd/3rd place then a 10th frame playoff will decide who goes onto the next game

Any ties in the final game of the step ladders will play a 10th frame playoff to decide the winner

The winner of that match will be declared winner of Open/Classic/Restricted Masters 2025

PRIZES – Open, Classic & Restricted Masters Winners:

1st Place - \$100 cash, shirt plus entry into the National Disability Masters (if attending) 2nd Place \$50

Please note that the prize fund might be reduced if less than 15 bowlers.

Entries / Payments will be via Tenpin Results



Should a refund of a bowler's entry fee be required due to event cancellation or otherwise approved by the tournament directors, the full amount paid will be transferred to the bowler's tenpinresults portal as a credit amount.

The bowler then has two options:

- a) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries via tenpinresults, or
- b) Request a cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee (3%) via tenpinresults
