# QUALIFYING

## DAY 1 - 6 SEP STAGE 1

All competitors will bowl 12 games in 2 separate 6-game blocks changing lanes after every 2 games.

Lane Re-Oil will occur after game 6. The TOP 14 boys & TOP 14 girls after 12 games of qualifying will progress to Sunday Elimination round.

# FINALS

## DAY 2 - 7 SEP STAGE 2

With pinfall carried over, the Top 14 Boys and Top 14 Girls will bowl 4 more games.

The Top 8 Boys and Top 8 Girls with the highest pinfall after 16 games will progress to Stage 3.

## STAGE 3

Top 8 boys and Top 8 girls will bowl 7 games of Matchplay. Bonus: 30 pins for a Win, 15 pins for a Draw. The Boy & Girl with the highest total pinfall plus bonus pins after all 3 stages will be declared the 2025 MELBOURNE JUNIOR CUP CHAMPION.

# RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Open to all 2025 TBA registered bowlers under the age of 18 as of 1st January 2025
2. This is a TBA-accredited event and all TBA Rules & Regulations will apply
3. One entry per bowler only
4. Ties after Qualifying, Elimination or Matchplay will be decided by a one-ball "Golden Ball" roll-off
5. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire at all times. No jeans, cords or tracksuit pants are permitted
6. Unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated
7. Ranking points will only be allocated to bowlers who are TBA Registered Silver members 24 hours prior to the event commencing
8. Refund of entries - should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credited amount. The player then has two options 1) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries or 2) Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee of 3%
9. The Tournament Director will decide any matter not covered in these conditions



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
