DAY 1 & 2-17 OCTOBER STAGE 1

All competitors will bowl 8 games in 1 block changing lanes after every 2 games.
Lane Re-Oil will occur after each of the three scheduled squads. The TOP 16 females & TOP 16 males after 8 games of qualifying will progress to the Finals on Sunday.

The TOP 16 will **include** the Defending Champions, and State/Territory Master representatives. All Defending champions and state/territory representatives must bowl qualifying for seeding purposes.

FINALS

DAY 3 - 19 OCTOBER STAGE 2

The top 4 will receive byes in stage 2 and recommence in stage 3. Pinfall carries from qualifying to Stage 2 with Seeds 5-16 to bowl six (6) additional games. The top 4 bowlers at the conclusion of Stage 2 will advance to Stage 3 as seeds 5-8 with pinfall to drop.

STAGE 3 - QUARTER FINALS

All Top 8 final matchups will be conducted in a best of 3 format.

- 0F1- 1v8
- QF2 -2v7
- QF3-3v6
- QF4-4v5

Winners to advance to Semi-Finals

STAGE 4 - SEMI- FINALS

- SF1: Winner of QF1 vs Winner of QF4
- · SF2: Winner of QF2 vs Winner of QF3

Winners progress to the Grand Final

STAGE 5 - GRAND FINAL

Winner of SF1 vs Winner of SF2

Winners are crowned Australian Masters Champions for 2025

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Open to all 2025 TBA registered bowlers in good standing and all non-resident bowlers who are a member of an affiliated federation who have attained the age of 18 or above prior to participating.
- 2. Defending champions and State/Territory champions must complete the minimum qualifying of 8 games for seeding purposes.
- 3. This is a nationally ranked event for both the TBA Open and Women's divisions. All participants wishing to be ranked for their performances will be required to be a TBA Silver Upgrade member at least 24 hours prior to the commencement of the event.
- 4. Bowlers outside of the Stage 2 Finals will receive ranking points based on their qualifying position.
- 5. Bowlers are required to check-in with the tournament team prior to the designated squad time each day of the tournament. Play will commence after a short briefing.
- 6. If a player fails to check-in for the Finals, the highest available non-qualifier will be invited to replace the absent player. The replacement bowler will be added into the final in seeding order based on their qualifying score. Once the Finals start, no further replacements will be permitted. Non-appearance will result in forfeiture of the games missed. From the completion of Round 3, non-appearance will result in the player present bowling without opposition, and advancing to the next round.
- 7. Bowlers not checked in by the advertised time will be disqualified and will have no claim on any prize money.
- 8. Any errors in scoring must be advised to the Tournament Director prior to the Prize Fund presentation. After that time all positions and payouts will remain as presented.
- Please note: TBA will be taking photographs and video throughout the 2025 TBA Australian Masters. If you do not wish for your image to be used, please advise the Tournament Director upon arrival.
- 10. Changes to the surface of balls must comply with TBA Rule 602.
- 11. No Smoking is permitted whilst a bowler is participating in the event until either the end of the day's play or the bowler is eliminated from the event.
- 12. Only competing players directly involved with this event may lodge a protest or results enquiry in relation to this event. This must be lodged in writing and signed and given to the tournament team within sixty minutes of the completion of the final frame of the tournament. After this time, the results will be considered as final and no further correspondence will be addressed by the tournament team.
- 13. This is a TBA-accredited event and all TBA Rules & Regulations will apply
- 14. One entry per bowler only
- 15. Ties after Qualifying, Elimination or Matchplay will be decided by a one-ball "Golden Ball" roll-off
- 16. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire at all times. No jeans, cords or tracksuit pants are permitted
- 17. Unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated
- 18. Ranking points will only be allocated to bowlers who are TBA Registered Silver members 24 hours prior to the event commencing
- 19. Refund of entries should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credited amount. The player then has two options 1) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries or 2)Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee of 3%
- 20. The Tournament Director will decide any matter not covered in these conditions
