GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. **This Tournament shall be accredited by Tenpin Bowling Australia Ltd and all TBA rules will apply.**
2. **Entries will be taken on the Tenpin Results Website ONLY.**
Refund Rule: Should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament Directors, the full amount paid will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options:
 - **Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries.**
 - **Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%).**
3. **Eligibility:** This Tournament is open to all Bowlers who have paid their 2025 registration fee with Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. and who are currently bowling in an accredited league at Townsville Tenpin & Fun Centre. A "Junior" is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 18 years on January 1st of the current year.
A "Senior" is defined as a bowler who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition.
4. In each grade each entrant will bowl Three (3) games in each Singles and Doubles and Teams in one block, changing lanes after each 3 games. In this event, a "block" of games constitutes nine games. Disability Championships will be Three (3) games, each Singles and Trios only.
5. Handicap in Adult and Junior Restricted Masters, Disability Masters, and Senior Masters will be 100% of 300.
6. Bowlers must use their highest league average over a minimum of twenty-four (24) games as of 30th September 2025. The T.B.A.T. Secretary will verify each bowler's average to be used in the Championships and Masters.
7. Bowlers without an average over the required number of games must apply in writing to the T.B.A.T. Secretary, who will consult with the Tournament Executive for classification, prior to submitting an entry. If no application is made, then the entering average shall be 200 for men and 190 for ladies.
8. The bowler's HIGHEST attempt in Singles and Doubles and Teams will be counted towards All Events. Mixed Doubles and Mixed Teams do count towards All Events. The Singles grade you are in will determine the All Events grade you are in. Disability All Events will be only Singles and Trios.
9. All bowlers must have entered and paid an All Events score to qualify for a 2025 master's Final. One Masters qualifying is automatic with your nine (9) game Championship entry. A bowler unable to comply with any of the rules must apply in writing to the T.B.A.T. Secretary who will consult with the T.B.A.T. Tournament Directors, TBAT Executive the Adult Representative and Junior Representative who will make a ruling on the matter. This decision is final.
10. Masters' Qualifying for Adult and Junior Sections will be their HIGHEST 9 game event series obtained in Championships. Disability Section will be highest 6 games event series in Championships.
11. Singles, Doubles and Teams Bowlers may have maximum of two entries in their own grade or a higher grade.



12. Any change to the original submitted entry form must be reported to the Tournament Directors no later than 30 minutes prior to the relevant squad time. Every attempt will be made to find a replacement bowler with a similar average so as not to alter the grade of the original entry. Entries will be graded up if the replacement bowler's average is higher but not graded down if the replacement bowler's average is lower.
13. Championship and All Events Prizes. Adult and Junior Sections. Payout of Prize Funds will be 1 prize for each 4 entries. Disability section will be an engraved Medallion awarded to first (1st), Second (2nd) and third (3rd) in each division (Male, Female,)
14. Ties in Championships and Masters' Qualifying and Masters' Finals.
CHAMPIONSHIP: All ties will be decided by the highest last scratch game bowled.
MASTERS QUALIFYING: HANDICAP SECTION: All ties will be decided by the highest last scratch game bowled plus handicap.
SCRATCH SECTION: All ties will be decided by the highest last scratch game bowled.
MASTERS FINALS: If there is a tie for first (1st) place at the end of the final a one (1) game roll off will be used to break the tie and extra tenth (10th) frames if needed thereafter. All other ties will share the positions.
15. Dress Code for Championships and Masters.
All bowlers bowling in this Tournament will be required to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt with sleeves, shorts or long pants for males and skirts, $\frac{3}{4}$ pants or long pants for females, neat, tidy, and modest attire at the discretion of the Tournament Directors. Torn or dirty clothing, singlets, leggings, bike shorts, Cargos, Board shorts, Denim, Track Pants or T Shirts are NOT permitted. Bowlers may not wear hats or caps whilst bowling. **HOWEVER: During Masters, the Dress Code will be a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt with sleeves, long black pants for males and Black skirts, black $\frac{3}{4}$ pants or black long pants for females, neat, tidy, and modest attire at the discretion of the Tournament Directors. Torn or dirty clothing, singlets, leggings, bike shorts, Cargos, Board shorts, Denim, Track Pants or T Shirts are NOT permitted. Bowlers may not wear hats or caps whilst bowling. You may only have your own name or no name on your shirt during the masters' Competition. This dress code will be strictly enforced.**
16. Bowlers must remain in the playing area until all play is completed.
17. No food or drink is to be brought into the playing area.
18. Smoking and the consumption of alcohol is not permitted during a block.
19. Apart from Medical Aids, No Electronic Earpieces, Headphones, or any other Electronic Device can be worn or used by bowlers whilst they are competing. The use of electronic devices such as mobile phones (including headphones/headsets) iPod and any other electronic devices are not permitted.
20. Bowlers must always conduct themselves in a polite manner. No bad or offensive language is to be used, and bowlers will refrain from kicking or otherwise abusing the ball returns or equipment. Unsportsmanlike remarks will NOT be tolerated. The Tournament Directors have the right to penalise bowlers for violations of the TBAL Code of Ethics. The yellow/red card system will be in force throughout this event.



21. NO bowler shall use any social media to defame or make derogatory remarks about any team member (including coaching or management), staff of Townsville Tenpin & Fun Centre, Tenpin Bowling Australia Ltd or Tenpin Bowling Association of Queensland or Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. or the sport of Tenpin Bowling.
22. Squad times are as per official sheet and no bowling will be allowed outside of these times.
23. ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6.00 PM FRIDAY 17TH OCTOBER 2025.
24. Any matter not covered by these rules will be decided upon by the Tournament Directors and, if required, the TBAT Executive, the Adult Representative and the Junior Representative.

2025 TOWNSVILLE DISABILITY MASTERS

This is a handicap Tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) and is open to all adult disability bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause.

QUALIFYING. Qualifying is 3 games singles and 3 games trios.

Averages are highest league average over 24 games as of 30th September 2025.

FINAL: The Final in each division will be made up of the Defending Champion (if eligible) and qualifiers to make a maximum total of 8 bowlers. Check in Closes at 9.00 am. Bowl at 9.15pm Sunday 9th November 2025. Any bowler not checked in prior to this time will be replaced by the first available reserve. Cost of Final \$75.00 Paid direct to Tenpin Results.

FORMAT: Finalists will bowl six (6) games in 3 x 2 game blocks with a lane change after each block, even lanes 1 pair to right, and odd lanes 1 pair to left. Total scratch pinfall plus handicap from the six (6) games will determine the overall placings.

PRIZE FUND IN EACH DIVISION:

Champion: A Townsville Disability Masters Shirt, Plus an Engraved Trophy
Plus, an unpaid entry into the 2026 Townsville Disability Masters
2nd Place an engraved Medallion. 3rd Place an engraved Medallion.

2025 SENIOR MASTERS

This is a handicap Tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) and is open to all adult bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause who have reached or will reach the age of 50 in the current year.

Averages are highest league average over 24 games as at 30th September 2025.

FINALS: The Final in each division will be made up of the Defending Champion (if eligible) and qualifiers to make a maximum total of 6 bowlers. Check in Closes at 12.30 pm. Bowl at 12.45 pm Saturday 8th November 2025. Any bowler not checked in prior to this time will be replaced by the first available reserve.

FINALS FORMAT: Finalists will bowl eight (8) games in 4x 2 game blocks with a lane change after each block, even lanes 1 pair to the right, odd lanes 1 pair to the left. Total scratch pinfall plus handicap from the eight (8) games will determine the overall placings.



PRIZE FUND IN EACH DIVISION.

Cost of Senior Master's Final will be \$130.00 paid direct to Tenpin Results. Champion will receive: First place: Trophy, Shirt, 50% of prize fund plus an unpaid entry into the TBAT Senior Masters 2026 (if eligible). Second place will receive 25% of prize fund. Third place will receive 15% of prize fund. Fourth Place will receive 10% of prize fund.

2025 TOWNSVILLE ADULT RESTRICTED MASTERS

This is a handicap Tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) and is open to all adult bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause and whose highest league average over a minimum of twenty-four (24) games as of 30th September 2025 does not exceed 169 for males and 159 for females. A bowler unable to comply with any of the rules must apply in writing to the Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. Secretary who will consult with the TBAT Executive and make a ruling on the matter. This decision is final.

FINALS. The Final in each division will be made up of the Defending Champion (if eligible) and qualifiers to make a maximum total of 12 bowlers. Check in Closes at 12.30 pm. Bowl at 12.45 pm Saturday 8th November 2025. Any bowler not checked in prior to this time will be replaced by the first available reserve.

FINALS FORMAT: Finalists will bowl eight (8) games in 4 x 2 game blocks with a lane change after each block, even lanes 1 pair to right, and odd lanes 1 pair to left. Total scratch pinfall plus handicap from the eight (8) games will determine the overall placings.

PRIZE FUND IN EACH DIVISION:

Cost of Adult Restricted Master's Final will be \$130.00 paid direct to Tenpin Results. Champion will receive: First place Trophy, Shirt, 50% of prize fund plus an unpaid entry into the TBAT Adult Restricted Masters 2026 (if eligible), Second place will receive 25% of prize fund. Third place will receive 15% of prize fund. Fourth Place will receive 10% of prize fund.

2025 TOWNSVILLE ADULT OPEN MASTERS

This is a scratch Tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) and is open to all adult bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause.

FINALS: The Final in each division will be made up of the Defending Champion (if eligible) and qualifiers to make a maximum total of 8 male and 8 female bowlers. Check in Closes at 5.30 pm. Bowl 5.45 pm Thursday 13th November 2025. Any bowler not checked in prior to this time will be replaced by the first available reserves.

FINALS FORMAT. Stage 1. The 8 male and 8 female bowlers will bowl seven (7) games Match Play Games. Points scoring: Points will be allocated for each head-to-head game based on the following: 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss. In the event of vacancies, a bowl playing against a vacancy will receive an automatic win for that game. The winner in each division will be the bowler with the highest points, with, for and against pinfall determining any ties.

Stage 2. The top 3 bowlers in each division will progress to a Step Ladder Final. (3rd Place to play 2nd place, Winner to play first place, with a two-game final)



PRIZE FUND IN EACH DIVISION:

Cost of Adult Open Masters Final will be \$170.00 paid direct to Tenpin Results. Champion will receive: First place Trophy, Shirt, 50% of prize fund plus an unpaid entry into the TBAT Adult Open Masters 2026 (if eligible) Second place will receive 25% of prize fund. Third place will receive 15% of prize fund. Fourth Place will receive 10% of prize fund.

2025 JUNIOR RESTRICTED HANDICAP MASTERS

This is a handicap Tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) and is open to all junior bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause and whose highest league average over 24 games as of 30th September 2025 does not exceed 145 for males and 135 for females.

FINALS. The Final in each division will be made up of the Defending Champion (if eligible) and qualifiers to make a maximum total of 12 bowlers. Check in Closes at 9.00 am. Bowl at 9.15 am Sunday 9th November 2025. Any bowler not checked in prior to this time will be replaced by the first available reserve.

FORMAT. Finalists will bowl six (6) games in 3 x 2 game blocks with a lane change after each block, even lanes 1 pair to the right, odd lanes 1 pair to the left. Total scratch pinfall plus handicap from the six (6) games will determine the overall placings.

PRIZE FUND IN EACH DIVISION:

Cost of Junior Restricted Master's Final will be \$110.00 paid direct to Tenpin Results. Champion will receive: First place Trophy, Shirt, 50% of prize fund plus an unpaid entry into the TBAT Junior Restricted Masters 2026 (if eligible) Second place will receive 25% of prize fund. Third place will receive 15% of prize fund. Fourth Place will receive 10% of prize fund.

2025 JUNIOR OPEN MASTERS

This is a scratch Tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) and is open to all junior bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause.

FINALS: The Final will be made up of the Defending Champion (if eligible) and qualifiers to make a maximum total of 8 bowlers. Check in Closes at 5.30 pm. Bowl 5.45 pm Thursday 13th November 2025. Any bowler not checked in prior to this time will be replaced by the first available reserve.

FINALS FORMAT. Stage 1. The 8 male and 8 female bowlers will bowl seven (7) games Match Play Games, Points scoring. Points will be allocated for each head-to-head game based on the following: 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss. In the event of vacancies, a bowl playing against a vacancy will receive an automatic win for that game. The winner in each division will be the bowler with the highest points, with for and against pinfall determining any ties.

Stage 2. The top 3 bowlers in each division will progress to a Step Ladder Final. (3rd Place to play 2nd place, Winner to play first place, with a two-game final)



PRIZE FUND IN EACH DIVISION:

Cost of Junior Open Master's Final will be \$150.00 paid direct to Tenpin Results. Champion will receive: First place Trophy, Shirt, 50% of prize fund plus an unpaid entry into the TBAT Junior Open Masters 2026 (if eligible) Second place will receive 25% of prize fund. Third place will receive a 15% of prize fund. Fourth Place will receive 10% of prize fund.
