**Restricted/Handicap Event**

The remainder of the field out of the cut will have their handicap added to their qualifying pin fall the top 4 bowlers in the handicap division will proceed to the final on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> May.

Handicap – 90% of 220 \*\*, averages submitted are to be taken from the bowler's highest league average over minimum of 16 games as at 15th April 2022. **Bowlers are to provide a certified average by your home Centre when checking in to be eligible to enter the Handicap Division (if not able to be verified via [tenpinresults.com.au](http://tenpinresults.com.au))**

\*\*The Tournament director reserves the right to alter the handicap percentage for the Handicap Division to comply with TBA Rules & Regulations.

**Under 21 SQ Challenge**

This is a scratch event open to all youth bowlers (male & female). Female entrants will receive a bonus of 8 pins per game.



## Rules & Regulations

TBA rules and regulations will apply and all bowlers must adhere to the following:

1. Be a 2022 TBA registered member and produce their card (or receipt) at check in.
2. For Queensland Junior Cup, be under the age of 18 as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022
3. For Under 21 SQ Challenge, be under the age of 21 as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022
4. Be a silver member to be eligible for ranking points (QJC only – Under 21 SQ Challenge is not ranked. .
5. Have their entry fee paid in full by 15th April 2022
6. Check-in by the advertised time.
7. Dress in appropriate bowling attire. Bowling shirt either with the bowler's name or an industry produced shirt, dress trousers, long dress shorts or skirt.
8. Have all bowling equipment meet TBA regulations.
9. The tournament Director and event staff have the right to check any equipment as they deem necessary.
10. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke or consume alcohol whilst competing in the tournament.
11. The Tournament Director and event staff has the final say in all matters.
12. Final placings will be determined by overall pin fall . In the event of a tie in "qualifying" the highest last game played by the participants will decide the winner. For the "Finals", any tie require a 1 game playoff. If scores remain tied after this, then a 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame shoot out will continue until the tie is broken.
13. **Finals:** In the event of a tie in the finals matches for open and handicap a 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame Rolloff will decide the winner.
14. If a bowler takes up the re-entry offer the two (2) highest 6 block scores will be used to determine their placing.
15. The approved COVID plan for Coolangatta Tweed Tenpin will need to be always adhered to. Strictly no contract (high Fives, hand shakes or team huddles are prohibited during the event). Subject to the number of entrants, we may need to restrict the number of spectators on the weekend of the event. We will advise any spectator restrictions after the close of nominations and prior to the event (rule 15 is subject to the prevailing COVID regulations at the time of the event).
16. Refund of Entry Fees – Should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options. 1. Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries or Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee ( 3%)

Squad G (Re-entries only) – Check in CLOSES at 3:00pm (Bowl 6 Games)

**PLEASE NOTE QUALIFYING FOR THE 2022 QJC IS 12 GAMES (you will need to nominate into a min of 2 squads). The Under 21 SQ Challenge qualifying will be over 1 squad (6 Games)**

Top 12 males (U18) and top 12 females (U18) on pin fall qualify for Stage 2 of the QJC  
The remainder of the U18 field out of the cut will have their handicap added to their qualifying pinfall. The top four bowlers will compete in handicap final.

**Only bowlers that have provided certified averages on or before check-in will be eligible for the Handicap division.**

**Top 4 Under 21 division will contest the final of the Under 21 SQ Challenge.**

### Monday 2nd May 2022

#### FINALS

**Check-in CLOSES at 7:30am for 8:00am start.**

The QJC Open, Restricted & Under 21 SQ Challenge finals will be run concurrently.

#### **QJC (U18 Open Boys & Girls)**

Top 12 boys & Top 12 girls, will bowl a further 5 games with pinfall to carry over. At the conclusion of these games, the field will be cut to Top 6 boys and top 6 girls – who will progress through to matchplay. Pinfall will carry over.

Matchplay – 5 games of head to head round robin, with 30 bonus pins for a win and 15 bonus for a tie. The Boy and Girl with the highest aggregate pinfall after the matchplay round (inc bonus pins), will be declared the 2022 Queensland junior Cup Champion.

## RESTRICTED DIVISION

Top 4 in the handicap division will contest the stepladder final. Pinfall will drop from qualifying.

Each Round will consist of 2 games with the winner of each round being the highest aggregate pinfall inc handicap

Round 1 Seed 3 v Seed 4

Round 2 Winner Round 1 v Seed 2

Round 3 Winner Round 2 v Seed 1

The winner of Round 3 will be declared the QJC Restricted Champion.

## UNDER 21 SQ CHALLENGE

Top 4 from qualifying will contest the final. Pinfall will be dropped.

Round 1 – All 4 competitors will bowl 1 game, with the lowest game eliminated.

Round 2 – Pinfall drops. The remaining 3 competitors from Round 1, will play a further 1 game, with the lowest pinfall for that game eliminated.

Round 3 – Pinfall drops. The remaining 2 competitors from round 1 will play a 2 game final, with the competitor with the highest 2 game pinfall over these 2 games, will be declared the Under 21 SQ Challenge Champion.

Award Ceremony will be conducted at the conclusion of the Finals.
