Atherton Atherton welcome you to the inaugural Atherton Avalanche Tournament that has been designed to give bowlers of all abilities access to the prize funds and competition that are usually only provided to the country's top level bowlers.

Combining with the wonderful support of local businesses in the Atherton community, it is NQ Tenpin's ambition to put the Atherton Tablelands on everybody's calendar to visit each year.



Qualifying (10 games)
All entrants will complete 10 games in one appearance in their nominated squad. 5 x 2 game blocks.



The Top 40 will bowl a further 4 games in 4 x 1 game blocks. Bowlers 21 to 40 bowling first, then followed by bowlers 1 to 20. At the completion of the 4 games, the Top 10 will continue on to the Matchplay Stage



The Top 10 will bowl 9 games Matchplay. Bonus pins will be 20 pins for a win and zero for a loss.

THE WINNER IS BASED ON TOTAL PINFALL FROM ALL SECTIONS OF THE TOURNAMENT PLUS BONUSES FROM MATCHPLAY.

(PINFALL CARRIES OVER)

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- This tournament is a handicap event, open to all bowlers who are 2021 TBA registered members.
- Average cutoff to be used for this event will be 12th May over a minimum of 24 games, or the final average for a completed league within the last 12 months, whichever is highest.
- Rolling Averages will be used in this event. Starting pinfall will be 10 x the entering average of this event. After the first game, this score will be added to the starting pinfall and divided by 11 to obtain the rolling average. Pinfall divided by 12 for the second game and so on and so forth.
- Handicap used for this event will be 100% of 250. In the unlikely event that a rolling average exceeds 250, provisions will be made to ensure that that base of the handicap is adjusted to 100% of the highest average in the competition.
- All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA Rules & Regulations.
- The International/National code of conduct rules apply.
- Bowlers are permitted re-entry into this event, however entering average will be compared to the final rolling average that the bowler completed in their first qualifying attempt. The highest average between these two will be used for re-entry.
- COVID RULES Strictly no Contact (High Fives, handshakes and team huddles are strictly prohibited during this event). Please limit the number of spectators at this event. Masks maybe mandatory owing to escalation of COVID circumstances, This will be advised at the start of the tournament.
- If the tournament is cancelled due to COVID19 a full refund of any monies paid will be remitted to entrants.
- Check-in and briefing will take place 30 minutes prior to each squad's starting time.
- All bowlers must wear acceptable attire. Male bowlers are required to wear tailored slacks or tailored shorts. Female bowlers may wear skirts, tailored slacks or tailored 3/4 shorts or skorts. Bowlers are required to dress for the event with a sense of respectability. Bowling balls may be checked by a tournament official during any stage of the event. It is the bowler's responsibility that all tolerances conform to TBA regulations. Use of an illegal ball is grounds for forfeiture of game, prizes, standings and possible disqualification, aside from penalties that may be imposed by TBA.
- Smoking and use of electronic equipment whilst competing is prohibited, including lane changes.
- Tie Breaking Procedures. In the event of a tie for 40th place after 10 games of Qualifying, or 10th place after the
 further 4 games, a Golden Ball (one ball, best pin count) roll-off will decide the placings. Should a tie occur after
 the completion of ALL games (after Matchplay) a one game roll-off will occur.
- OILING: Uniform oiling shall be used throughout the entire tournament.
- Protests must be lodged with the Tournament Director within 15 minutes of the completion of bowling in which
 the incident occurred. In the case of Matchplay, protests are to be lodged prior to the next round.
- PINFALL Carries over in all phases.
