TOURNAMENT FORMAT - RAY HULME GRADED

This is a six (6) game handicapped event for both male and female Adult bowlers. Men and Women will bowl in the one division and must have an average that does not exceed 185 at the time of competition. All bowlers shall bowl six (6) games changing lanes after each game. The bowler with the highest total pinfall including handicap at the end of the six (6) games will be declared the winner for the day. If a tie exists for first place at the end of the six (6) games the bowler with the highest last game including handicap will be declared the winner. If a tie still exists scratch tenth frame roll-offs will occur until a winner emerges.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT - JUNIOR HIGH ROLLERS

This is a six (6) game scratch event. There will be separate divisions for both males and females. All bowlers shall bowl six (6) games changing lanes after each game. The bowler with the highest total pinfall at the end of the six (6) games will be declared the winner for the day. If a tie exists for first place at the end of the six (6) games the bowler with the highest last game will be declared the winner. If a tie still exists tenth frame roll-offs will occur until a winner emerges.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT - JUNIOR PIN MASTERS

This is a six (6) game handicapped event for Junior bowlers. Boys and Girls will bowl in the one division. All bowlers shall bowl six (6) games changing lanes after each game. The bowler with the highest total pinfall including handicap at the end of the six (6) games will be declared the winner for the day. If a tie exists for first place at the end of the six (6) games the bowler with the highest last game including handicap will be declared the winner. If a tie still exists scratch tenth frame roll-offs will occur until a winner emerges.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT - JUNIOR POCKET ROCKETS

This is a three (3) game handicapped event for Junior bowlers. Boys and Girls will bowl in the one division. All bowlers shall bowl three (3) games on the same pair. The bowler with the highest total pinfall including handicap at the end of the three (3) games will be declared the winner for the day. If a tie exists for first place at the end of the three (3) games the bowler with the highest last game including handicap will be declared the winner. If a tie still exists scratch tenth frame roll-offs will occur until a winner emerges.

TIME AND DATE

Sunday, 5th June 2022, Check-in by 9.00am for a 9:15am start. Bowlers that are not checked-in by the advertised time will bowl from the frame that they arrive. Entries close when squads are full.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. This centre is TBA registered, and has a government approved COVID plan or guideline in place.
- 2. This accredited event will be held in accordance with any current guidelines as set out by state government, ensuring centre capacity and social distancing requirements are adhered to.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the Centre to be across any other COVID requirements that may be in force and follow COVID safety plan requirements regarding other areas of business that the centre may conduct.
- 4. This tournament is open to all Junior & Adult bowlers who are 2022 TBA Registered Players and financial 2022 SA Junior Circuit members or 2022 Ray Hulme Graded Circuit Members.
- 5. To be eligible for the Adult Ray Hulme Graded division bowlers must be over the age of eighteen (18)years as of 1st January 2022 and must have an average that does not exceed 185 at the time of competition.
- 6. To be eligible for the Junior High Rollers division bowlers must not have reached the age of eighteen (18) years as of the 1st of January 2022.
- 7. To be eligible for the Junior Pin Masters division a bowler must not have reached the age of eighteen (18) years as of the 1st of January 2022 and must have an average that does not exceed 160 at the time of competition.
- 8. To be eligible for the Junior Pocket Rockets division a bowler must not have reached the age of eighteen (18) years as of the 1st of January 2022 and must have an average that does not exceed 134 at the time of competition.
- 9. This is a TBA accredited tournament and all TBA rules and regulations will apply.

10. Handicaps for Graded Bowlers will be established at 100% of 200 taken from their highest league average in the week before the tournament and must be verified by their local bowling centre. A standing sheet must be supplied to verify your current average otherwise you will not be permitted to bowl.

11. Dress Code:

- Male entrants are permitted to wear long dress pants and a collared shirt or approved bowling shirt. Jeans, shorts, ¾ length pants, cargo pants or tracksuit pants are not permitted.
- Female entrants are permitted to wear long dress pants, dress shorts or skirts and a collared shirt or approved bowling shirt. Jeans, ¾ length pants, cargo pants or tracksuit pants are not permitted.
- 12. The Tournament Director reserves the right at any time to check any bowler's equipment. Any equipment that is found to be in breach of the TBA rules will result in the disqualification of that bowler with no claim to any prize money.
- 13. Any matters not covered by these rules will be under the jurisdiction of the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.
- 14. The TBA Code of Ethics will apply to this tournament and will be enforced in accordance with that policy.
- 15. No bowler will be permitted to smoke or consume alcohol during a session of play.
- 16. Any appeals or protests must be lodged with the Tournament Director within 30 minutes of the alleged infringement.
- 17. Refund of Entry Fees Should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options
 - Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
 - Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%)

FEES AND PRIZES

The cost for the tournament will be \$75 for Ray Hulme Graded, \$65 for High Roller division bowlers, \$50 for Pin Masters division bowlers, and \$30 for Pocket Rocket division bowlers, the breakdown of these costs is detailed below. An annual Circuit Membership Fee of \$10 for Ray Hulme Graded, High Rollers and Pin Master bowlers and \$5 for Pocket Rocket bowlers will be required to be eligible to bowl in any tournament through-out the year.
