This event will include the Junior Cup and the Youth Cup being bowled at the same time. Junior bowlers wishing to have their score count towards the Youth Cup will need to pay the additional fee.

## QUALIFYING

This is a scratch event with all participants bowling 10 games over two sessions on day one of competition. The Junior winners will be decided at the conclusion of Qualifying. Top 8 Youth Males and top 8 Youth Females after qualifying will progress to the Matchplay Final on day two.

## MATCHPLAY

The top 8 Youth Males and top 8 Youth Females will bowl 7 games matchplay with matchplay bonuses of 20 for a win and 10 for a draw. Pinfall will carry over from Qualifying. The Youth Male and Youth Female Champions will be the bowler with the highest pinfall including matchplay bonus.

## NOMINATIONS

Nominate online at https://www.tenpinresults.com.au and a $\$ 70$ deposit will be required to secure your position.

## FEES

Entry to the event will be $\$ 245$ for Youth bowlers and $\$ 225$ for Junior bowlers for Junior scores to count towards the Youth Prize Fund an additional $\$ 65$ will be required.

## COVID GUIDELINES

- The Centre is a TBA registered, and has government approved COVID plan or guideline in place.
- This accredited event will be held in accordance with any current guidelines as set put by state/territory government, ensuring centre capacity and social distancing requirements are adhered to.
- It is the responsibility of the Centre to be across any other COVID requirements that may be in force and follow COVID safety plan requirements regarding other areas of business that the centre may conduct.
This is a TBA Nationally Ranked Junior \& Youth Tournament and all TBA Rules and Regulations will apply with all bowlers having the following requirements.
- 2022 TBA Memberships and produce their card at check-in.
- Bowlers wanting to receive ranking points must be registered Silver members prior to the first ball being bowled.
- This tournament is open to all TBA Registered Players who had not reached the age of 21 years for Youth Bowlers and 18 years for Junior Bowlers as of the 1st January 2022.
- Bowlers not checked in by the advertised time for qualifying will need to attend a briefing prior to bowling and will commence in the frame that is in progress.
- Dress in suitable/appropriate bowling attire
- The Tournament Director reserves the right at any time to check any bowler's equipment. Any equipment that is found to be in breach of the TBA rules will result in disqualification of that bowler with no claim to any prize money.
- The TBA Code of Ethics will apply to this tournament and will be enforced in accordance with that policy.
- No bowler will be permitted to smoke or consume alcohol during the tournament.
- Any appeals or protests must be lodged with the Tournament Director within 30 minutes of the alleged infringement.
- Entries will be accepted until squads are full.
- Any bowler not checked in for Final by 8.45 am on Sunday $21^{\text {st }}$ August will be replaced by the next available bowler.
- Any ties will be decided by the highest last game, except if a tie exists for ${ }^{\text {st }}$ place after the completion of matchplay. In this case a 1 game roll off will be conducted. Subsequent ties will be broken by $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll offs until a winner emerges.
- Refund of Entry Fees - Should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options
- Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
- Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. ( $3 \%$ )
- No refunds will be issued for bowlers withdrawing from the tournament after play has commenced.
- Any matters not covered by these rules will be under the jurisdiction of the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.
