Lanes change every 2 games.

Up to 4 bowlers per pair.

MATCH PLAY FINAL - PINFALL DROPPED

The top 15 bowlers on handicap pinfall after Qualifying will progress to match play consisting of 7 games, 3 way match play. Bonus pins applied will be 20 pins for 1st, 10 pins for 2nd and 0 pins for 3rd place each match.

MATCH PLAY POSITIONAL ROUND - PINFALL CARRIES

At the completion of match play, bowlers will be seeded 1—15 for a final positional game E.g. 1 v 2 v 3, 4 v 5 v 6, and so on down to 15th.

- Smoking, alcohol and use of mobile phones will not be permitted whilst competing.
- The tournament directors reserve the right to scrutinise any equipment at any times. Any non-sanctioned equipment or equipment to be found non-compliant or in breach of TBA rules and regulations by any bowler, will result in instant disqualification and no claim to any prize money.
- Ties. In the result of any ties after qualifying for the Top 15, the highest last games with handicap will decide the highest position. At the end of Match Play, if any ties, a 1 game play off will decide the highest position. If a ties for 1st after positional round occurs, a 1 game play off will take place to determine a winner. If still tied, a single ball playoff will be used to break any further tie.
- Any bowler to not check-in for any Final rounds on time will be replaced by the first available placegetter, e.g. top 15, if 1 person fails to check-in then 16th place will be offered a spot to progress and so on until place is filled.
